
Measuring carbon footprint

- three scopes of greenhouse gas emissions



Scope 1 emission

Emissions from activities at companies' sites **under their control** for generating power and steam.


For example for a jeans manufacturer, emissions can come from indigo dyeing or denim washing under their roof.

SF6

Scope 2 emission

Relates to **indirect CO2 emissions** from suppliers.

For a jeans manufacturer, these can include emissions produced by suppliers in generating steam and electricity.



Scope 3 emission

Are from sources not owned or controlled by the company, and can occur along a value chain.

For a pair of jeans, emissions happen from the purchase of the raw materials like cotton.

Then the fuel used in transporting materials from suppliers and the products to customers.

An employee taking a bus to work, or a salesperson flying to see a customer also accounts for Scope 3.





Even if we decide we no longer want the jeans, how they are disposed or recycled, and emissions generated during the process is also Scope 3.
